



MARKET REPORT – WEEK 3

BASED ON SALES AND PURCHASES OF VESSELS WEEK ENDED FRIDAY 22ND JANUARY 2021.

President Biden is now in the White House and we wait to see how he manages to deal with not only the pandemic on his doorstep but just as importantly how he might sooth the USA's foreign trading partners and international alliance members (eg NATO and WHO) who have been left feeling rather battered and bruised by the previous Trump administration. Biden appears to be saying all the right things so far but we wait to see whether his far less confrontational approach reaps rewards and progress or is instead taken as a sign of weakness.

Meantime Covid-19 continues to wreak havoc around the world with even more virulent strains of the virus being identified and the numbers of infections and deaths increasing again in many countries especially in Europe. It would appear that fighting viruses is one thing that totalitarian governments are able to do better than normal western democracies due to their ability to exercise an extremely high degree of control over public and private life i.e. when such governments declare a lockdown people do stay at home and international travel (in or out) is halted.

The Baltic Dry Indexes enjoyed a clean sweep of gains last week with the BDI itself improving by +3.2% w-o-w to close at 1810 points. The individual end of week results were BCI +2.7%, BPI +2.7%, BSI +5.2% and BHSI +2.6%. So, with even Handysizes (38k bulkers) now averaging over \$12,000 daily, the dry freight market is continuing to make steady progress. Accordingly, Bulker S+P activity also remains bullish in respect of both demand and values with Capesizes currently especially popular purchases.

While both the Baltic wet indexes actually improved last week, the BDTI by +3.9% and the BCTI by 9.7%, the overall tanker market remains poor with spot rates still at or below opex for many vessels. With oil for transport demand still terribly reduced due to Covid lockdowns, and about 160 million barrels of crude oil and clean products still remaining in floating storage tanker spot rates and values are unlikely to improve soon.

It would appear that the sub-continent recycling markets overheated themselves recently with breakers across all 3 regions bidding in the regions of \$460-480 per LDT. With domestic steel prices now moving lower those levels have now proved to be unsustainable with several such sales now facing difficulties and market levels retrenching to region \$420-460 with Bangladesh currently paying the highest followed by Pakistan then India.
