



MARKET REPORT – WEEK 29

BASED ON SALES AND PURCHASES OF VESSELS WEEK ENDED FRIDAY 22ND JULY 2022.

Bad news constantly dominates the news feeds whether it be rising Covid numbers, Russia / Ukraine war, food shortages, high power and fuel costs, inflation, and excessive heat waves (which maybe acceptable if you are on holiday but bad news if you are trying to work, travel or nearby forests are on fire).

Last week saw the BDI lose just a little further ground of -0.2%, due to the BCI reducing by -7.6% while the BPI, BSI and BHSI gained +11%, +2% and +2.5% respectively. We expect the 20 million tons of Grain that Russia last week agreed to release from Odesa will soon have a positive impact on the dry freight market, as will also be the case if / when the Chinese later in the year again start to import Iron Ore from Australia, having sanctioned same since October 2020. So while bulker S+P activity is currently much reduced in volume of deals done, values are currently holding and it seems we can expect further improvements into the Autumn and last quarter.

Tankers on the other hand are currently where the action is as rates and values have increased substantially since Russia invaded Ukraine at the end of February: Period tanker rates remain firm with Non-Eco and Non-Scrubber fitted tankers obtaining 12 months T/C rates of \$27,000/day for MR tankers, \$20,250/day for LR1 tankers, \$30,000/day for LR2 tankers, \$26,000/day for Aframax, \$20,000/day for Suezmaxes, and \$19,000/day levels for VLCC's. Regarding values, since the war started, 15 year old MRs have increased 50% from \$11 m to 16.5m, while same age Aframax have jumped 64% from \$16.5m to \$27, and 15 year old VLCC values are now up 36% having increased from about \$21 mio to \$28.5 mio.

The recycling markets in the subcontinent and Turkey remain confronted by an extremely difficult trading climate of feared recession, falling steel prices, increased interest rates, domestic currency devaluations against the dollar and at the same time having to offer rates attractive enough to attract the few ships that are made available to them. Subcontinent rates on offer remain in the region of \$525-560, while Turkish levels are currently region \$240-\$260 depending on the vessel type etc.
